

Frodsham's Christmas Festival 25th November

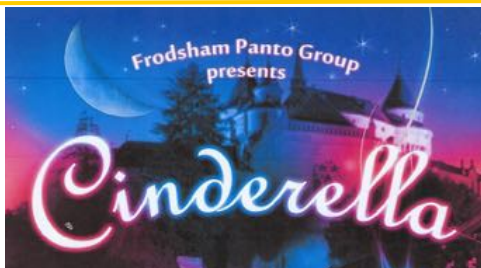

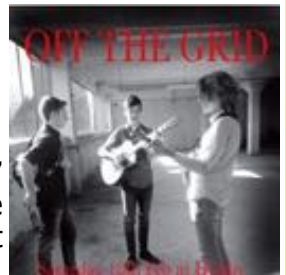
