

# F14 Grand Prix at Frodsham Community Centre

Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> September 2014

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

Entry is conditional on payment of entry fee and subject to terms and conditions of entry as set out below.

### **Race Course**

All events will take place on Frodsham Community Centre Field on a specially created F14 Grand Prix race track.

The course/ track for all events is over rough/bumpy grass

Teams can be made up of between 2 and 4 persons.

All competitors must be aware of the terms and conditions of entry

Judges will inspect all 'vehicles' before the start of each race

FCA has the right to refuse entry to any 'vehicle' deemed to be unsafe by the judges

Vehicles may carry sponsorship and advertising

### **Soap Boxes**

The best dressed vehicle competition is open to all vehicle entries and will take into account the best engineered soap box cart and the most original and best turned out team

### **Race Categories for Carts**

- Friends & Family
- Youth Groups/Schools
- Businesses/ Services
- Charity Groups

### **The Race Programme**

Races will be held for each category of cart. Heats will depend on number of entries.

The Grand Final will include the winner from each category.

Open Racing for Wheely bins, wheelbarrows and baby buggies will take place throughout the afternoon.

Free entry and open to all subject to scrutiny.

### **Entry Fees:**

Soap –box Carts: £5.00 (including free entry for teams of up to 4 persons)

### **Registration**

You can register at The Race Track (on The Centre field) from 12.00 – 12.45pm on Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> September

Soap Boxes (carts) can be entered by teams of no more than 4 persons of which only 2 persons at one time can participate in the race event.

All Vehicles

- must be self-design and construction – not purchased
- must carry at least one passenger
- must have a minimum of three wheels
- must be powered by one person - pulled or pushed, no pedals
- must be suitable for 'racing' over grass
- passenger must wear head protection
- where a passenger is under 5 years of age the vehicle must be 'propelled' by a person 16 years or older.

- where the passenger is 5 to 10 years of age the vehicle must be 'propelled' by a person of equal age or older
- may be decorated and/or carry advertising or sponsorship

**Organisers cannot be responsible for accident or injury caused to or by the drivers/vehicles**

## ***Baby Buggies***

Baby Buggy teams will consist of no more than two persons

All Buggies

- must have a minimum of three wheel
- must carry only one passenger no younger than 12 months old
- passenger must be properly secured and wear head protection
- where a passenger is aged between 12 months and 5 years the pusher/ driver must be 16 years of age or older.
- where the passenger aged between 5 and 10 years the buggy pusher/driver must be 'propelled' by a person of equal age or older than the passenger
- may be decorated and/or carry advertising or sponsorship

**Organisers cannot be responsible for accident or injury caused to or by the drivers/vehicles**

## ***Wheelbarrows***

Wheelbarrow teams will consist of no more than two persons

Wheelbarrows:

- must have no more than one wheel
- must carry only one passenger no younger than 5 years
- where a passenger is aged between 5 years and 10 years the pusher/driver must be 16 years of age or older.
- passenger must wear head protection

**Organisers cannot be responsible for accident or injury caused to or by the drivers/vehicles**

## ***Wheelie Bins***

Wheelie Bin teams will consist of no more than two persons.

Wheelie Bins :

- must not carry any passenger
- drivers must be at least as tall as the wheelie bin they are pushing/pulling

**Organisers cannot be responsible for accident or injury caused to or by the drivers/vehicles**

## ***DECLARATION:***

By registering for the F14 Grand Prix in whichever category and in paying the entry fee you are declaring in respect of each team member that they have read and understood the terms and conditions of entry and understand that they enter at their own risk, all team members are medically fit to take part, and that the organisers shall not be responsible for any injury or accident caused to or by a competitor during this event and have no claim against the organisers (Frodsham Community Association) in the event of any injury or accident that may occur whilst taking part in this event

Furthermore in respect of any competitor/team member aged 16 years or younger on the day of the event you are declaring that the team member has the consent of their parent or guardian to take part in this event and that the parent/guardian understands the terms and conditions of entry.
