Born, raised and died in Denmark so how can it be British?

The resolution passed at Frodsham W.I. 's Annual Resolution meeting held on 6th May calls on H.M. Government to introduce clear and mandatory country of origin labelling on all meat, poultry and fish products sold in this country.

The discussion was led by Frodsham member Cath Stone and it was revealed that it is currently perfectly legal for the country of origin to be declared as the one where a product undertook its last significant change. So, for example, a pig born, raised, slaughtered and cured in Denmark can be legally sold as British bacon simply because it is sliced and packed here, which is surprisingly deemed as significant change.

Advice from the N.F.U. is to look out for the little red tractor logo which guarantees products are made from British reared animals.

We hope the motion is passed nationally and then we can all get to work raising the profile of an issue which seriously affects the opportunities for our farmers to promote their products clearly to consumers.

Margaret Wright, from Helsby W.I. will be representing several local W.I.s at the national conference in Cardiff later this year.
