The course will discuss the 2021 Booker prize winner - Damon Galgut's 'The Promise' alongside the 2019 winner Bernadine Evaristo's 'Girl, Woman, Other'. In addition Evaristo's memoir 'Manifesto: On Never Giving Up' will be considered.

South African writer Galgut's novel explores the complicated world of South African society and politics through the story of the Swarts. Evaristo's novel of modern Britain and womanhood employs an experimental and poetic form as it follows the lives of several generations of women. Evaristo's memoir explores her rebellion against the mainstream, and her commitment to community and creativity.
