## We'll Meet Again

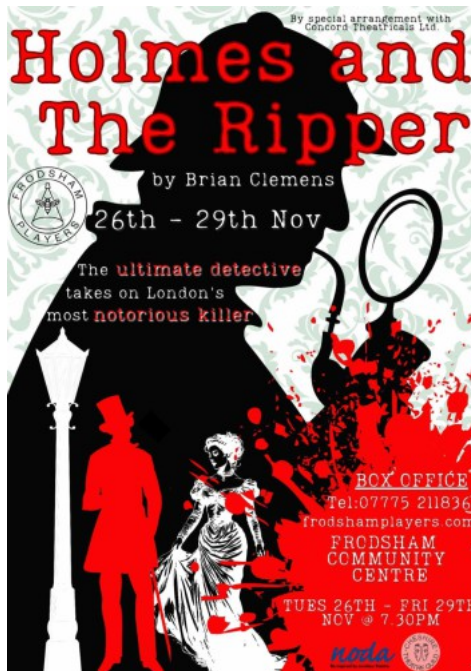
10th November 7.30pm

We are delighted that Iain Bennett, who won the Best Director Award for Around the World in 80 Days returns to Frodsham Players to direct.

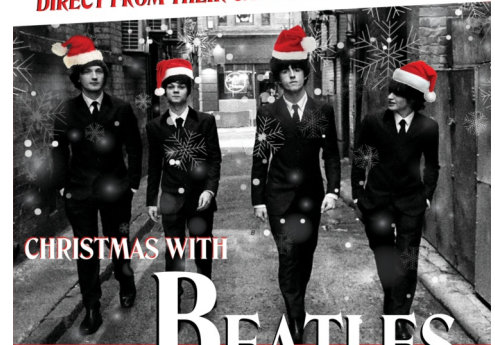
