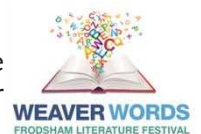
### WEAVER WORDS FESTIVAL 3 - 11 MAY 2025

Save the date for the next exciting Weaver Words Literature Festival to be staged at Frodsham Community Centre and other local venues for nine days early in May.

Poet Lemn Sissay will headline an impressive line-up of speakers, events and writing workshops, which also includes an amazing one-man performance of Dicken's classic story 'Nicholas Nickleby' by his great, great grandson Gerald Dickens.

'A Celebration of Cheshire' will be the theme for this latest festival, shining a spotlight on the many fascinating literary connections with the county, including a tour of Lewis Carroll's birthplace and visitor centre at Daresbury Church, and a delightful afternoon tea in the company of Nell Stevens, author on Mrs Gaskell's Knutsford connections. Local writer Lynn Pegler will be launching a new collection of entertaining poems taking the audience on a fascinating illustrated tour 'Around Cheshire in 100 Poems and Pictures'.

The festival will again be staging its popular Poetry Wall, where anyone can display a short poem on a postcard. And all would-be writers are invited to submit entries for the prestigious Adult Flash Fiction Competition (short stories up to 300 words) and the Children's Great Weaver Words Writing Prize (Key Stage 2 & 3, aged 7-14).
