A recipient of top prizes at many international piano competitions, established virtuoso pianist Andrew Wilde has received rave reviews in the UK, Europe and the US. His 2023 recital for the Club, music by Mozart, Beethoven and Chopin, was one of the most electrifying events we had ever put on, producing a rapturous response from the large audience, many of whom could scarcely believe they had experienced a performance of that intensity here in Frodsham. April's event will be a high point of the Club's current concert season, to which visitors are welcome for an admission fee of £10.

As those who have been fortunate enough to catch them in full flight will testify, a Jaywalkers show is an exhilarating experience. UK-based they may be, but many from the other side of the Atlantic have complimented them on their particularly stylish delivery of this virtuosic brand of Americana. These three outstanding musicians have developed a tight bond, demonstrated through their well-crafted, tasteful arrangements and ability to bounce ideas around the stage. The combination of powerhouse bass, flame-fingered mandolin, blistering fiddle and three-part harmony pack a punch as fiery as Jay's lead vocals and make a fuller sound than expected from an acoustic trio.

After years of touring and perfecting their craft, Jaywalkers are ready to release their highly anticipated new album, Move On, set for release in Spring 2025. With this new record, the band pushes the envelope further than ever before, fusing Bluegrass, Country, Folk & Americana with their signature virtuosity, humour & skill to create something that's both fresh and familiar. Whether you're a longtime listener or a newcomer, Move On promises to captivate and resonate on multiple levels.

There's no better way to experience Jaywalkers than in person. Their live shows fun, intimate, and full of the kind of energy that can only come from a band completely immersed in the music they create. In 2025, Jaywalkers will be taking the stage for an extensive "Album Launch" tour, bringing their new album to fans around the UK. £500 prize money is on offer for the best bite-sized short stories of 300 words or less in the Frodsham Flash Fiction Prize, sponsored by the RSK group. Deadline is Sunday 6 April 2025.

Adults are invited to join one of four creative writing workshops at the festival. There are specialist sessions on writing children's picture books with Iryna Garkusha, flash fiction with the

competition judge David Gaffney, journal writing with former Chester Cathedral Poet-in-Residence Julia McGuinness, and a special poetry workshop aboard the Danny steamship moored at Anderton Boat Lift, with Shropshire poet Jean Atkin.

The festival's popular Pop-Up Poetry Wall will make a welcome return to Frodsham Community Centre throughout April and May. Everyone is invited to submit a short 'poem on a postcard' inspired by this year's festival theme, 'A Celebration of Cheshire'.
